



MADUCK — Mrs. Annie Maduck of Calgary, formerly of Yorkton, widow of Tony Maduck passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 31, 2000 at the Rosedale Hospice in Calgary. She was 76 years of age. Annie Maduck was born at the family farm on January 5, 1924, daughter of Mike Teslak and Katie Maciuk. She received her education at Smokside School. Ann and Tony knew each other a long time before they became close friends. In September, 1942 Tony asked Ann to marry him and in November they were united in marriage. That winter they lived with Tony's parents. In the fall of 1943 they moved to Toronto and lived with sister Mary and brother-in-law Steve Zablotzky. In 1944 their daughter Irene was born. In November, 1945 Tony and Ann moved back to Saskatchewan to farm. In 1950 their son Nick was born. They farmed until the fall of 1952 and sold what they had to move to Agincourt, ON, where they operated a summer market garden while Tony went to work at Messey Ferguson Farms for the rest of the year. In 1966 they moved back to Yorkton. While Tony worked as a carpenter, Ann worked as a sales clerk for the Mat and Zellers, retiring in 1985.

After Tony passed away in 1985, Ann and Irene moved to St. Albert, AB in the summer of 1987 to be closer to Nick and his family. In 1992 Nick and his family moved to Calgary. A year later Ann and Irene also moved to Calgary to be near Nick and his family whom she loved so dearly. Predeceased by her husband Tony in 1985, her parents, Mike and Katie; brothers, Alex, Steve, Matt and Andrew, and sister Mary Zablotzky, Annie leaves to cherish her memory a daughter, Irene; son Nick (Lorraine) and four grandchildren, Dana, Sean, Erin and Joel. She is also survived by brothers, Bill (Mary) Teslak, Joe (Ivy) Teslak and Paul (AnneMarie) Teslak; sisters, Sophie Koptie, Kay (Harry) Blahut, Rose Kowch, Ruby Hebert and Nancy (Matt) Novak and her sisters-in-law Lee Teslak and Isabel Teslak, as well as many nieces and nephews and all the members of the Maduck family whom she also loved dearly.
