**MALONEY**—On Tuesday, March 15, 1983, Mrs. Elizabeth Clara Maloney, late of #5 - 2755 - 31st Avenue, Regina and formerly of Lebret, Sask., passed away at the age of 70 years after a lengthy illness. Clara was predeceased by her mother, Anna in 1938; her father, Michael Salamon in 1957; three sisters: Cecilia in 1913, Agnes Paquin in 1965 and Mary LaRocque in 1968 and one brother, John in 1972.
